## Personal, social and emotional development

- Learn/follow class rules and routines
- Display high levels of involvement in activities
- Work as part of a group

#### Mathematics

- Counting 1-10, then 1-20 forward and back
- Count objects reliably 1-5, then 1-10 and beyond
- Recognise numerals zero to 5, then 10 and above
- Sort and match objects
- Use mathematical language such as circle, square, triangle, rectangle, cube, sphere, more, less, shorter, longer
- Compare objects by size categorising into 'big' and 'small', long and short
- Comparing objects by weight
- Explore and make patterns
- Finding shapes in the environment.

## • Understanding the World

- Topic Traditional tales and Nursery rhymes
- Spring walk
- Spring festivals —Chinese New Year, Mothering Sunday, Easter
- Look closely at similarities and differences, patterns and change over time.
- Know how to operate simple equipment
- Show an interest in ICT and become more competent when using the computer, Interactive whiteboard and iPads
- Talk about significant things that have happened to them.
- Show care and concern for the environment.

# Expressive Arts and Design

- To use different media
- To use glue appropriately
- 2D and 3D work
- To explore what happens when they mix colours
- To develop painting skills
- To experience painting and drawing from observation
- To join in rhymes and chants
- To build a repertoire of songs
- To explore the different sounds of instruments
- Begin to make constructions
- Engage in imaginative and role play

#### Physical Development

Gross motor

- Move freely with pleasure and confidence
- Jump off an object and land appropriately
- Experiment with different ways of moving

#### Fine motor

- Explore malleable materials by patting, stroking, poking, squeezing, pinching and twisting them
- Correct pencil grip
- Hold and use scissors correctly Show increasing control over clothes and fastenings
- Thread beads, use peg boards
- Design and make structures with construction kits e.g. duplo, mobilo
- Understand that equipment and tools have to be used safely
