Personal, social and emotional development

- Select and use activities and resources, with help when needed.
- Play with one or more other children.
- Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting.
- Increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important.

Literacy

- Enjoy sharing books with an adult.
- Enjoy drawing freely.
- Talk about books and what they have just read.
- Learn new vocabulary from books and begin to use it in their speech.

Communication and Language

- To be able to listen for an increasing length of time.
- To enjoy listening to stories and recall what they have heard.
- Understand instructions with 2 parts.
- Join in with singing Nursery Rhymes and songs.

Mathematics

- Quickly recognise a group of up to 3 objects without needing to count them.
- Count past 5.
- Show numbers on our fingers up to 5.
- Say one number name for each item in order – 1,2,3,4,5.

Understanding the World Autumn 1 and Autumn 2

- Talk about what they see (inc. Forest school visits)
- Begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.
- Continue developing positive attitudes about the differences between people.
- Know that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Take part in simple pretend play, using an object to represent something else even though they are not similar.
- Remember and sing entire songs.
- Explore colour and colour mixing.

Physical Development

- Move freely with confidence.
- Jump off an object and land appropriately.
- Experiment with different ways of moving.
- Explore malleable materials by patting, stroking, poking, squeezing, pinching and twisting.
- Correct pencil grip and use scissors correctly.
- Show increasing control over clothes and fastenings.
- Thread beads, use peg boards.
- Design and make structures with construction kits e.g. duplo, mobile, box modelling
