Spelling and Grammar

- Mostly taught in school with vocabulary books sent home to revisit misspelt words
- Weekly Grammar lessons

Science

This term we are introducing the new **Rising Stars** Science scheme. **Pupils will study the following topics:**

• Mirror, mirror

How light is reflected How shadows are formed Shadows through the course of a day

What's that sound?

How sound travels How sounds are created and heard when something vibrates How sound can be altered

<u>Music</u>

Music lessons will follow the **Music Express** scheme of work which uses a topic based approach. The main focus areas still include vocal skills and instrumental work.

Topics will include:

- Building which focusses upon musical structure and building layers including ostinato patterns
- Around the world which focusses on pentatonic melodies and syncopated rhythms

The three classes will also prepare for an Easter Show.

<u>Maths</u>

Number

- Place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Ongoing tables and related division facts

Shape and Measures

- Measurement (length, mass and capacity)
- 2D and 3D shapes
- Time

Data Handling

Collecting, classifying and interpreting data

Children will be encouraged to develop their mastery skills through the use of manipulatives and other resources.

P.E.

Swimming

 This term Hazel class will be swimming on Monday mornings (Please ensure all girls have a swimming hat and remove their earrings)

Children <u>may</u> wear their tracksuit and trainers to school on the day they swim.

Indoor and Outdoor P.E.

Pupils will be taught to:

- use running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination
- play competitive games, modified where appropriate and apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending
- develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance [for example, through gymnastics]
- perform dances using a range of movement patterns
- compare their performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement

Computing

This term we are following the Rising Stars scheme. The children will study the following topics:

Investigate a range of filming techniques Plan, edit and create own films

In all topics we shall promote E-safety.

History

The historical focus this term is: **How much did the ancient Egyptians achieve?**This topic covers themes including life and death, family roles, pyramids, pharaohs and religion

Art

This term's topic is called: **Can we change** places?

Children will consider what makes places different and how art can be used to improve an environment.

They will also design a sculpture.

Geography

The geographical focus this term is: Can you come on a great American road trip?

During this topic, the children will develop their understanding of the countries, states, capitals and cultures of North and South America. They will develop their map reading skills and use an eight point compass to compare locations.

Design and Technology

This term/s topic is called: **Photograph Frames**

The children will explore free-standing structures and design and make their own photograph frame.

French

Weekly French lessons are taught by Mrs Mishan. This term the main topics include clothes and colours.

Please provide a water bottle for your child and ensure that it is refilled every day. Please ensure that all school uniform, including indoor and outdoor PE kit, is clearly labelled with your child's name.
