Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the Summer term. This has been another extraordinary year so far and it is remarkable to be saying we are in our last term in Nursery! With the warmer weather comes lots of outside learning and exciting enrichments.

With this letter is attached an overview of some of the things your child will learn this term.

Topic

This term we will be doing 'Nursery Rhymes' as a topic. Nursery rhymes are fantastic for promoting early literacy skills such as spoken language and for introducing interesting vocabulary. The structure we will follow will be to focus on a rhyme a week/fortnight and enjoy lots of other rhymes along the way. We aim for the children to know the rhymes and be able to join in accurately.

Uniform

This half term the children have a choice to wear the summer uniform. The full uniform list is available on the school website. Please make sure children wear closed toe shoes, no sandals.

As the weather improves please bring your child into school with a sun hat and wearing sun cream. We do offer free flow between the outside and inside areas for the children however we do not anticipate having much shade in our EYFS outside area.

The children will also need to keep bringing their water bottle and this will be available for them during the session.

Nursery Garden

Unfortunately we have little shelter from the elements in our new garden. This has meant that in wetter months we have not been able to have the garden set up before the children arrive. Now the weather is improving and we have had a chance to see what space we have with all the children back we will have more set up in advance. Please may we ask that you do not allow your child or their siblings to play with the equipment in the garden whilst you are awaiting to drop them off.

Snack

Snack money is £14 for the summer term. The only method of payment is now via the app 'School Gateway'. As always, the money is used to provide the children with a healthy snack and pay for enrichments such as playdough ingredients.

Farm Trip

This year it will not be possible to take the children offsite for a class trip so we have decided to recreate a trip on site. Please look out for details which we will send home shortly.
