Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Take risks and explore within the environment.
- Be confident to try new activities, initiate ideas and speak in a familiar group.
- Continue to be interested, excited and motivated to learn.
- Maintain attention, concentrate and sit quietly when appropriate.
- Respond to significant experiences.
- Form good relationships with adults and peers.

- Initiate conversation and use talk to extend play.

Understanding the World

- Topic focus. Life cycles, Space, hot countries.
- Summer walk looking for seasonal changes.
- Look closely at similarities and differences, patterns and change.
- Use skills such as cutting, joining and folding.
- Develop skills using a range of tools and techniques safely.
- Know how to operate simple equipment.
- Become more competent when using the computer

Expressive Arts and Design

- To use different media
- To use glue appropriately
- 2D and 3D work.
- To develop painting skills
- To experience painting and drawing from observation
- To join in rhymes and chants
- To build a repertoire of songs
- To explore the different sounds of instruments
- Begin to move rhythmically.
- Engage in imaginative play and role play

Physical Development

- Move freely with pleasure and confidence.
- Jump off an object and land appropriately.
- Experiment with different ways of moving.

Fine motor

- Explore malleable materials by patting, stroking, poking, squeezing, pinching and twisting.
