Pope Francis:

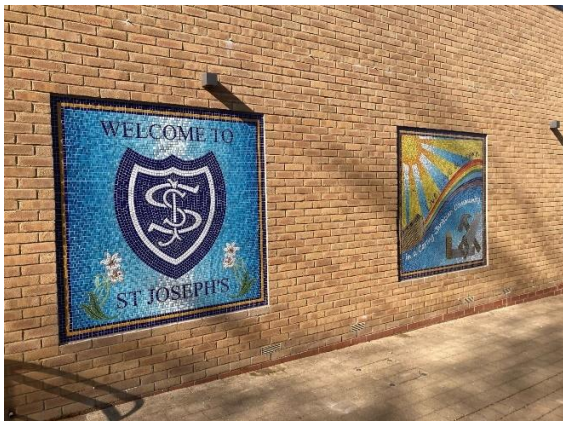
