KS1 & KS2 Information Sessions

Wednesday 19th September: 09.15-09.55; 15.40-16.20

Monday 24th September: 15.40-16.20

Q. Are the sessions for the parents or pupils?

A. The sessions are for parents as an induction to the class your child is in, the routines they will be following and the expectations we will have of them. It is also a chance to meet your new teacher if you have not had that opportunity already.

Q. Do I have to go to all three sessions?

A. No – you will only need to go to one session. The same session content is being repeated three times to allow parents with more than one child in KS1 and KS2 the opportunity to attend their child's session. In addition, the content will be published on the school website for any parent who is unable to attend one of the three sessions.

Q. Why is there no session for EYFS?

A. EYFS parents had their induction session before the summer holiday and have regular show and share sessions throughout the year.

Q. Is this a chance to talk about my individual child's progress with my teacher?

A. No - the opportunity for this will be at parent consultations on either Tuesday 20th or Thursday 22nd November.

Q. Do I need to book a session like parents consultations?

A. No - please just turn up to one of the sessions. Teachers will ask you to sign in the classroom for our records of attendance.

If you are attending the session on:

Wednesday 19th September 09.15-09.55

Please bring your child to the classroom as normal and then wait outside the classroom until the teacher brings you in at 09.15. The pupils will have had registration and then will be brought down to the Hall for assembly. The pupils will return to class at 10.00, at which point parents will need to leave the school site via the outside classroom doors.

If you are attending the session on:

Wednesday 19th September 15.40 – 16.20 <u>OR</u> Monday 24th September 15.40 – 16.20

Please pick up your child as normal at the end of the school day and bring them around to the Hall doors where they will be met by staff. You will be asked to sign in your child so that we have a record of which parent is here. If you have a child in Reception or Nursery as well as in KS1 or KS2, they can also be left with the staff in the hall. Staff will look after them with a DVD until 16.20. At 16.20, please pick up your child from the hall and leave the school site via the hall doors.

Unfortunately for safety we will not be able to use the playgrounds for parking.
