Pupil Premium Grant expenditure 2018/19

The Government give all maintained schools money to support the learning of pupils receiving free school meals – this is known as the Pupil Progress Grant (PPG).

Since 2012, all schools are required to publish how the grant was spent for the previous year.

<u>Objectives in spending PPG:</u>	
To ensure pupils achieved their end of year targets in reading and writing in order for them to be on track to achieve at least age related expectations in reading, writing, maths and science at the end of Year 6.	
To ensure pupils make at least expected progress in reading, writing and maths at Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2	
To ensure pupils make similar or better progress and attainment than pupils nationally	
<u>Summary of spending and action taken:</u>	
The grant was spent providing:

Pupil progress was monitored during the school year on a termly basis by each class teacher and member of the Senior Management Team.

There was one pupil receiving PPG in Year 2 and two pupils receiving PPG in Year 6 in the academic year 2018/19. Below is the most recent data for PPG pupils at the end of either Key Stage.
