Welcome to the first newsletter from Kier Regional Building Eastern. These regular publications will keep you updated with progress on site and what to expect in the months ahead. We will highlight recent construction works, as well as what to expect in the upcoming months.

About the project

The project will consist of a new replacement 420 pupil primary school on the existing site with the main classroom and administration accommodation being 2 storey. There will also be new external soft and hard play areas, associated groundworks which include re modelled car park, external drainage and external service upgrades.

This will expand from a 1.5FE to a 2FE School which will provide an additional 105 pupil places once complete.

Forthcoming works:

Early site set up works shall consist of installation of initial site office and welfare provisions and the establishment of site security systems, including secure fencing and signage to the site boundary. This will also include tree felling works.

Following this; our ground-works subcontractor shall then commence operations on site, including earthworks and substructure excavations.
