

Year 3 English (Home Learning - Week 1)

This week's online English lessons will be taught by Miss Saab and Miss Johnson will focus on **Grammar**. Each lesson will build on from the previous one, so it's really important you complete them in order. Spellings will continue in the same way using Spelling Shed. Your child may like to take note of the focus words in these slides as well.

The lessons consist of a video with slides. Each lesson begins with the teacher introducing what will be taught throughout the session. The slides will contain learning, recaps and the activities that you need to complete. Some of the lessons may introduce a key word or two. Why not try to impress your family by using these words when you speak to them! The main focus for today is to recognise, read and write compound sentences using the co-ordinating conjunctions (but, and, or) to connect your two main clauses.

This lesson will begin with a short recap of what we have learnt so far. Today Miss Johnson will introduce you to subordinate clauses and you will learn how they can be added before or after a main clause. You will also read and write complex sentences, about polar bears, using subordinate clauses.

Today's lesson starts with a recap of what you have learnt about complex sentences so far.
