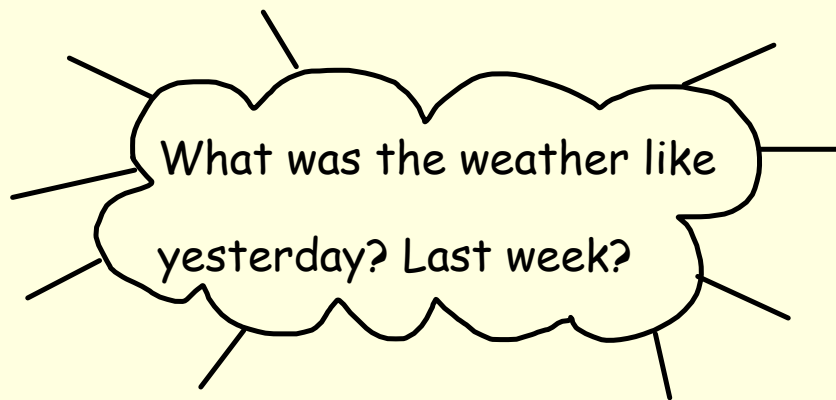




observe the weather and understand weather data

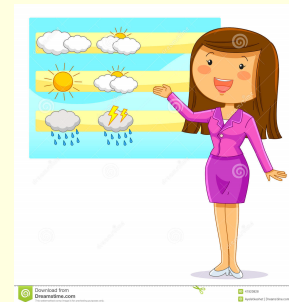


How do we know what the weather will be like tomorrow or next week?
