Strategy Statement

Children and young people across the country have experienced unprecedented disruption to their education as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19). Those from the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds will be among those hardest hit. The aggregate impact of lost time in education will be substantial, and the scale of our response must match the scale of the challenge. Schools' allocations will be calculated on a per pupil basis, providing each mainstream school with a total of £80 for each pupil in from Reception through to Year 6.

Barriers to learning created by our school closure in March 2020 and January 2021 include: high anxiety for a small minority of pupils; missed learning experiences; lack of extended writing during lockdown; lack of structured physical education.

The key priorities for our use of the COVID catch up premium will be:

- 1. Developing our online learning provision to ensure pupils can access regular live and recorded lessons
- 2. Providing 1:1 and small group interventions in phonics, reading writing and basic number work across the school
- 3. Providing our most vulnerable pupils with additional support to help lower their anxieties in school
