## **Class Organisation for September 2021**

As you will be aware, the school has been expanding for the last three years in agreement with the Local Authority as we move each year closer to being 2Forms of Entry (FE) 60 pupils per intake, rather than the historic 1.5FE, 45 pupils per intake. With this come changes to the structure of our classes and the eventual phasing out of mixed aged classes. For the upcoming academic year, our first cohort of 2FE pupils will be entering Year 3 and KS2. As a result, our class structure will be:

Our aim is to keep numbers in each of the classes to a maximum of 30 in total, although this may not be always possible at KS2 due to the Local Authority having to place children in schools that are full in order to give them an education.
