

## KS2 Results - 2017

This is the second year of the new Key Stage 2 tests in maths, reading and SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar). The tests assess children against a national standard. Pupils' results in each test are reported using a scaled score, with 100 being the expected standard for Year 6. Writing judgements were formed by Teacher Assessment.
