

## KS1 Maths Home Learning -

We are working from White Rose Home Learning (see link for website above) for our Maths lessons. You will need to be connected to the Internet to watch the videos. Each lesson will begin with a video which will show you your learning for the session. During the video, your child may be asked to pause it and complete some of the questions on the worksheet. Please feel free to watch the videos as many times as required. For each lesson, there is an activity worksheet for your child to complete, as you are now unable to download these from the free version of the website, we will upload these worksheets to your Seesaw account. If you're unable to print off the work, complete it on a piece of paper or in a book. Once you have finished, you may wish to go through your answers with a family member using the answer document for the lesson. There is also an answer worksheet provided on the website for each of the lessons. The timings of each of the lessons vary slightly; some may be shorter than others. In school we aim to teach 1 hour of Maths a day, therefore you may wish to include different Maths activities at home. These activities could include counting and adding different objects in the garden, baking or online Maths games. We really hope you enjoy the lessons.
